

Cyprus hosts SIPS 2019

The SIPS 2019 Sustainable Industrial Processing Summit & Exhibition takes place from 23 - 27 October 2019 in Paphos, Cyprus. There are in excess of 450 papers expected from around 60 countries. This yearly event is deeply science-focused and industrial engineering-oriented, having been organised since 2003 by the not-for-profit corporation FLOGEN Stars Outreach (www.flogen.org), which is dedicated to achieving sustainability through science and technology. Following the rich tradition of previous years, the summit will cover 3 sustainability pillars:

- (1) Science, Technology & Industry,
- (2) Governance & Management and
- (3) Education & Civil Society.

There are ten honorary Symposia covering, e.g. Mining and Smelting (Dr. Krishna Parameswaran), Materials Recycling (Prof. Pavel Kozlov), Alloys, and various Chemistry Branch Applications, as well as further themed Symposia on other aspects of Sustainable Industrial Processing. Six Nobel Laureates

Sulphur is focus in Houston

The next CRU Sulphur 2019 + Sulphuric Acid Conference and Exhibition takes place from 4-7 November 2019 in Houston, Texas. For more than 30 years, the conference has been a premier event for anybody working in sulphur and sulphuric acid production, consumption and trade. Over 50 papers will be delivered and over 70 exhibitors are expected, along with over 500 delegates.

Following site visit and workshop events on 4 November, the market outlook and the IMO 2020 Regulations will be debated on 5 November. Then the Industrial Sulphuric Acid Streams on 6 - 7 November will feature papers on digitalisation, energy recovery, emissions management, corrosion protection, improving plant performance, and mist elimination technology. The heat recovery workshop on 6 November will focus on various aspects of engineering, specifications, and operation and maintenance of heat recovery systems from the energy rejected from acid systems, including:

World Copper Conference runs in March 2020

CRU's 19th World Copper Conference takes place from 23 - 25 March 2020 in Santiago, Chile as part of the annual CESCO Week program. Themes in 2020 will reflect the market conditions as was the case in 2019, when rising mining costs, the impact of Chinese government legislation to ban scrap imports, sustainable copper and traceability, and forecasts for green technology were some of the key topics.
