1. Introduction



 Recently, there are many events focusing upon the Impacts of IT and AI against Legal Communities.

- It is a proof that lawyers are now frustrated by the immediate development of IT and AI in the legal field.
- Try to describe the present situation by the development of Online Dispute Resolution (ODR) and some others which are using IT and Al.

2. An Impact of IT & AI against the Dispute Resolution -ODR-

- US: Private Sectors have explored the Online Dispute Resolution Services for High Volume Low Value Cases.
 ex. 60 million filings per year to the eBay's ODR
- *EU:* ODR Regulation obliges e-commerce venders to provide a link to connect ODR service providers recommended by EU, especially for *Cross-Border Consumer Cases.*
- Japan: It is one of the hot issues whether or not ODR should be one of the next important governmental policies.

2. An Impact of IT & AI against the Dispute Resolution -ODR-


• UN: UNCITRAL organized the ODR WG and it established Technical Note on ODR for the harmonization of ODR systems.


 APEC: APEC established the Model ODR Procedural Rules based on the UN's concept for the uniform operation of ODR.

• *ISO*: ISO has just started discussions on ODR for the standardization.







- No more use of lawyers.


< Virtual Digital Room in M&A>

- The data will be categorized by a computer software without human power for the smooth operation of the due-diligence research.

Automatic Evaluation by AI will be realized soon or later.

<E-Discovery in the US Litigation>



 All the digital data somehow relating to the case has to be exchanged between the parties.

- The data will be checked by a computer software without human power according to the promised conditions.
- The data deeply relating to the case will be found without lawyers.

- <Initial Coin Offering (ICO) in Finance>
- Many business corporations started to gather money from the public not by IPO but by ICO using Cryptocurrency.
- They tried to avoid too complicated regulations and high cost of financial institutions and lawyers.
- Some States started to provide new rules for ICO in order to encourage ICO inside of their markets.
