SIPS 2020 & 2021 is an annual international conference organized by the not-for-profit corporation FLOGEN Stars Outreach (www.flogen.org) dedicated to science and technology. This year, SIPS2020&2021 is in honor of **Prof. Ferid Murad** who was awarded the **1998 Nobel Prize in Physiology/Medicine** for his breakthrough discovery on nitric oxide in the cardiovascular system paving the way for many other well-known medical innovations.
